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# Public Health Questionnaire

## Urgent Attention: Your Application Cannot Proceed Without This

Dear Licensee

For your application for a liquor licence to proceed, the Medical Officer of Health (MOH) needs to report to the District Licensing Agency within a short timeframe. To report, the MOH needs to understand your host responsibility and public health measures.

The questions in the attached Public Health Questionnaire enquire whether you:

- **Ensure that no intoxication or presence of minors occurs on your premises.**
- **Help patrons slow their rate of drinking and of alcohol absorption by offering food and non-alcoholic drinks.**
- **Reduce the risk from fire.**
- **Reduce the likelihood of drink-driving by helping patrons find alternative transport.**

Please fill in the questionnaire and **return it within 5 working days** of receiving it in the enclosed stamped addressed envelope. It is important that you return it on time. The Medical Officer of Health may oppose your application unless he is satisfied that your premises do not present any health risk.

Every licensee is legally responsible for the operation of their premises. Therefore, even if you employ an agent to assist you with the licensing process, we strongly recommend that you fill in and understand the questionnaire yourself, otherwise ensure that you read and understand the questionnaire fully before signing it.
